GRADING SYSTEM


In the French academic system, grades range from 0 to 20, 0 being the lowest grade and 20 the highest!

| French Grade | ECTS GRADE | DEFINITION |

| 16 - 20 | A | Outstanding performance with only minor errors |
| 14 - 15,99 | В | Above the average standard but with some errors |
| 12 - 13,99 | С | Generally sound work with a number of notable errors |
| 11 - 11,99 | D | Fair but with significant shortcomings |
| 10 - 10,99 | Е | Performance meets the minimum criteria |
| 8 – 9,99 | Fx | Fail – some more work required before the credits can be awarded* |
| 0-7,99 | F | Fail – considerable further work is required |



...Yet French cinema is a significant part of Parisian and French culture, and one of the top reasons that foreigners come to Paris is to experience France's rich and diverse culture...




