

## Visas & Immigration

#### EU Citizens EEA & Swiss Nationals

- No Visa needed for studies of less than 6 months
- Passport Mandatory (you cannot travel with your identity card) valid for 6 months from the day you enter the UK

## Non-EU & International Citizens

- Standard Visitor Visa for studies of less than 6 months
- Carte de séjour valid until the end of your stay in London
- Passport is Mandatory

#### Certificate

 OMNES Education specific certificate will be provided

#### Work & Internship

 Work is not permitted under Standard Visitor Visa
